# Centenary Glory

CENTENARY PARK 21.8.82.

ON A OVERCAST AFTERNOON AT CENTENARY PARK CITY WERE HOST TO HIGH FLYING VISITORS POLONIA. CITY WERE LOOKING FOR BOTH POINTS AND REVENGE FOR THE LOSS RECEIVED AT RALEIGH RESERVE EARLIER IN THE SEASON.

THE OPENING MINUTES SAW BOTH SIDES PROBING FOR AN EARLY GOAL, THE FIRST REAL CHANCE CAME FROM NOTHING WHEN STEWART WHO'D PUSHED RIGHT UP INTO THE ATTACK HIT A RASPING DRIVE FROM THE EDGE OF THE BOX, WHICH BEAT THE KEEPER AND UNLUCKILY HIT THE UPRIGHT. CITY HAD A LUCKY LET OFF WHEN MARSHALL THRASHED A FIRST TIME SHOT FROM 20 YARDS PAST KEEPER PETERSEN BUT A POLONIA PLAYER WAS ADJUDGED OFFSIDE ONCE AGAIN AS THEY HAD BEEN SEVERAL TIMES BEFORE. THE MOST MEMORABLE INCIDENT AFTER THIS WAS WHEN BUCHANAN WITH A STRONG RUN DOWN THE RIGHT KNOCKED ACROSS A ACCURATE BALL TO THE NEAR POST WHERE CAMPBELL HAD POSITIONED HIMSELF, HIS REFLEX HEADER NARROWLY MISSED. H.T. 0-0. TOMMY ROBERTSON MADE A SUBSTITUTION BRINGING ON THE HARD RUNNING GOLBY FOR CAMPBELL WHO' RAN HIMSELF INTO THE GROUND WITH HIS UNSELFISH RUNNING AND WORK OFF THE BALL.

SECOND HALF CONTINUED IN THE SAME MANNER AS THE FIRST WITH BOTH TEAMS THRUSTING FORWARD.

SOME SUPERB SAVES FROM PETERSEN KEPT CITY IN THE GAME. TUTTILL BY NOW HAD COVERED EVERY INCH OF THE PARK WITH HIS PHENOMENAL WORK RATE AND LOOKING DANGEROUS WHENEVER HE RECEIVED THE BALL.

A SECOND SUBSTITUTION CAME WHEN WHITESIDE REPLACED SEKULSKI.

THE TURNING POINT OF THE MATCH CAME WHEN WHITESIDE WON POSSESSION JUST IN POLONIA'S HALF AND HIT A LONG BALL DEEP INTO THEIR HALF, THE BALL LANDED IN THEIR 18 YARD BOX AND WITH A CULMINATION OF ERRORS IN POLONIA'S DEFENCE ALLOWED WALL TO STRIKE THE BALL HOME, ALL SEEMED SET

FOR FRANKSTON CITY TO COAST HOME THE FINAL TEN MINUTES DANGER LOOMED FOR CITY WHEN THE EXPERIENCED PETERSEN WAS SEEMINGLY CONNED BY THE POLONIA FORWARD AND MADE THE MISTAKE OF TAKING TO MANY STEPS. A FREE-KICK WAS GIVEN TO POLONIA ON THE 18 YARD LINE. THE KICK WAS CHARGED DOWN BY TUTILL AND THE IMMEDIATE DANGER OVER.

FRANKSTON SUPPORTERS BREATHED A SIGH OF RELIEF, WHEN THE BALL WAS PUMPED BACK INTO THE BOX AGAIN, WITH TWO MINUTE LEFT THE JUDGE THAT BUCHANAN THE SCOTTISH WIZARD HAD NUDGED CZAPNIK OFF THE BALL. A PENALTY! IT SEEMED THAT FRANKSTON'S LUCK HAD FINALLY RAN OUT. BUT KRYSINKI SMASHED THE BALL OVER THE CROSSBAR, SUBILATION AND REUSE COVERED CENTENARY PARK AS MINUTES LATER THE REF BLEW FOR FULL-TIME. SCORE 1-0 TO CITY.


